COMMUNITY FACTS

Located in Townsend, North Middlesex Regional High School serves the towns of Pepperell, Ashby and Townsend. The rural atmosphere and proximity to major cities and business centers make the area attractive to many of the nearly 20,000 residents of the district. Townsend is located approximately 40 miles west of Boston and 30 miles north of Worcester.

SCHOOL INFORMATION

North Middlesex Regional High School is a comprehensive public school accredited by the New England Association of Secondary Schools and Colleges. Enrollment for grades 9-12 is around 1000 students. There are 71 teachers, providing a 15:1 student/teacher ratio. The student/counselor ratio is 250:1.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

1. Credit Requirements 140 credits
2. The following subject credits must be earned as part of the graduation requirements:

English	20 credits
Social Studies	20 credits
Mathematics*	15/20 credits
Science*	15/20 credits
World Language**	10 credits
Health, Nutrition, Fitness	5 credits
Technology Tools	2.5 credits
Arts	2.5 credits

* Each student must successfully complete at least 15 credits in both science and mathematics and 5 additional credits in either science or math for a total of 35 credits.

CLASS RANK

Class rank is a cumulative computation of a student's academic standing in his/her class. It is a weighted ranking system where both levels and course grades are used to determine Quality Point Average (QPA) and class standing. Summer school grades are not calculated in QPA.
