Dear Seniors and Parents of Seniors:

Attached is a copy of the 2017 application for NMRS scholarships. All seniors who plan to continue their education in the academic year immediately following their high school graduation and who have applied for admission to a program of higher learning at a school, college, or university are invited to apply. The Scholarship Committee cannot award scholarships to students attending prep schools.

Scholarship awards are based on **academic, Foundation drive/volunteer, as well as school and community participatory information**. Because the amount of scholarship funds is limited, the Scholarship Committee must make hard choices. The attached application is the main source of information used for these determinations; therefore, **THE INFORMATION SUPPLIED MUST BE COMPLETE AND ACCURATE**.

Note: *If the recipient of an award is unable to enter a program of higher learning by September following his/her high school graduation, the award is forfeited. We are also unable to honor admission deferments of any kind, including public service, religious, or military (with the exception of a military draft).*

In order for the Scholarship Committee to have ample time to consider all applications carefully, it is important that the **paper application be returned to the Guidance Office in person on or before Friday, March 31, 2017.** **Incomplete or late applications will not be considered. No applications are accepted by email.**
